

As a supplier to Tilka Trading AB, you are expected to follow current regulations and directives in REACH, RoHS, SCIP and additional updates in these and inform Tilka Trading AB immediately in the event of changes that mean that the regulations or directives are no longer complied with.

RoHS/ELV

Directives 2011/65/EU and 2015/863 Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) of the European Parliament and of the Council of the European Union requires the restriction of the use of lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls (PBB), and polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) in electrical and electronic equipment. Directive 2000/53/EC-End of Life Vehicles (ELV) of the European Parliament and of the Council of the European Union requires the restriction of the use of lead, mercury, cadmium and hexavalent chromium.

REACH/SCIP

Regulation 1907/2006 EC Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemical substances (REACH).

The REACH Regulation requires supplier of articles in EU to communicate information about components and articles containing identified “substances of very high concern” (SVHC).

Delivered components to Tilka Trading AB may not contain substances listed on the SVHC Candidate list in a concentration above 0,1% weight by weight (w/w).

Companies within EU supplying such articles must also submit information to ECHA (SCIP database).

Companies outside EU must supply Tilka Trading AB with enough information about the articles to be able to fulfil these legal obligations.

SCIP is a database (Substance of Concern in articles as such or in complex objects (products)). The purpose of this legislation is to phase out chemical substances that are of concern to humans as well as the environment.

All supplier of articles on the EU market is obliged to register information about these substances, according to REACH Candidate List and concentration above 0,1 % w/w, in to the SCIP database.
